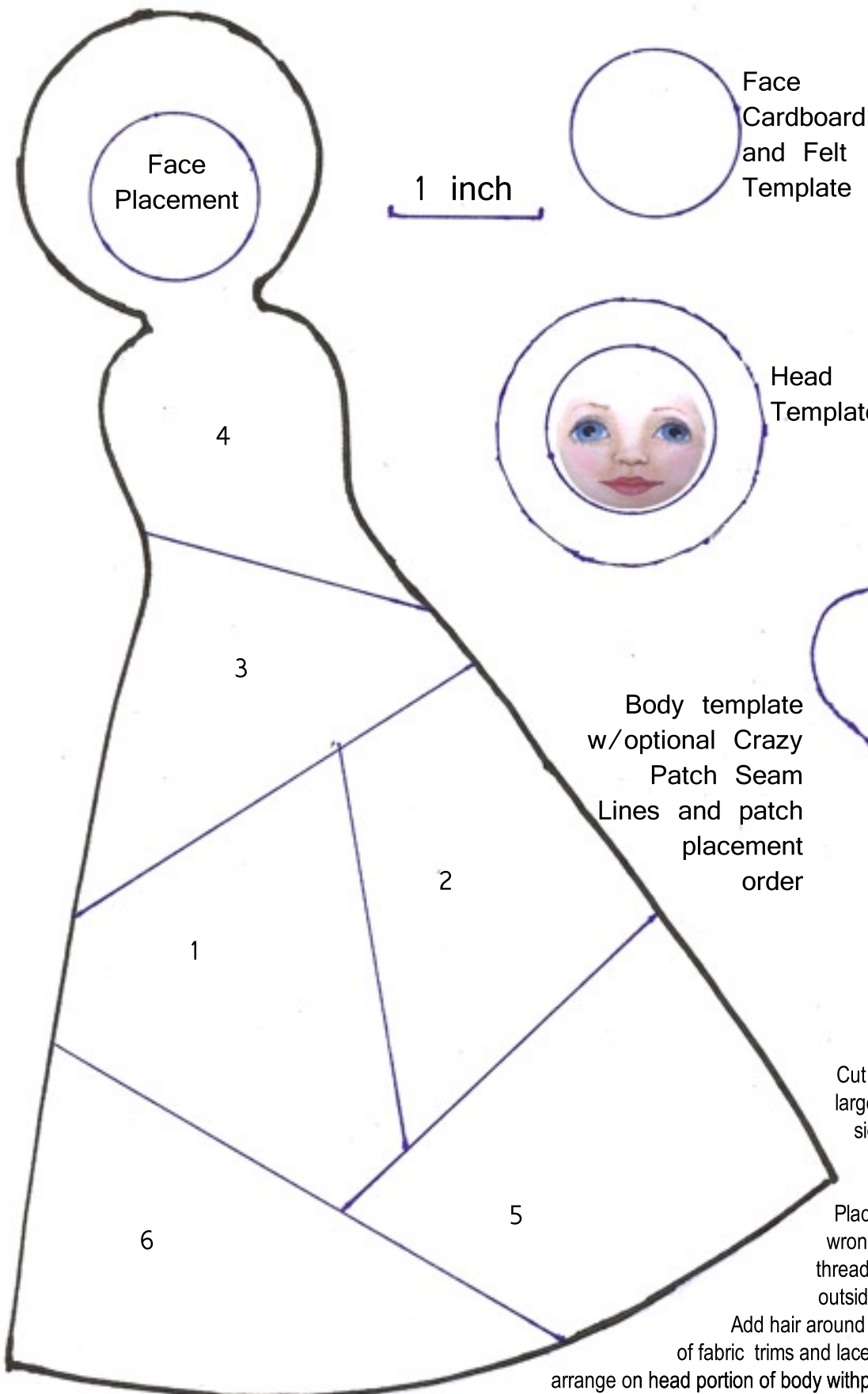


Angel Ornament

Basic Directions

Cut body template from stiff felt. Cut a piece of fabric for the base 1/2" larger all around. Place felt on wrong side of base fabric and glue edges to back of felt. Cut out template for face from cardboard and felt.

Place felt on cardboard and place on wrong side of face fabric. With strong thread, make a running stitch all around outside of head. Pull tightly and secure.

Add hair around face. Embellish body with scraps of fabric trims and lace. Cut 3 hearts from template and

arrange on head portion of body with points in the center. Glue face on

head. Cut a piece of 2" wide ribbon 8" long. Fold in thirds so the ribbon is about 3/4" x 8" and glue or sew together. Make a knot in the center. Bring sort cut edges to body back and arrange so knot falls where hands would be. Cut off excess if any and glue to back. Glue a popsicle stick down the body center from the tip of the head. Cut a piece of ribbon 7" long and fold in half. Glue cut edges to back of head to form a hanging loop. Make wings from a 4" x 1 1/2" piece of lace or similar fabric. Fold in quarters and cut a half oval making the center of the oval the long fold and leaving a small section at the short fold so when opened it forms a figure 8. Stiffen with dimensional paint, glue or glitter glue and adhere to the back. Cut a piece of felt from the body template and glue to back.
